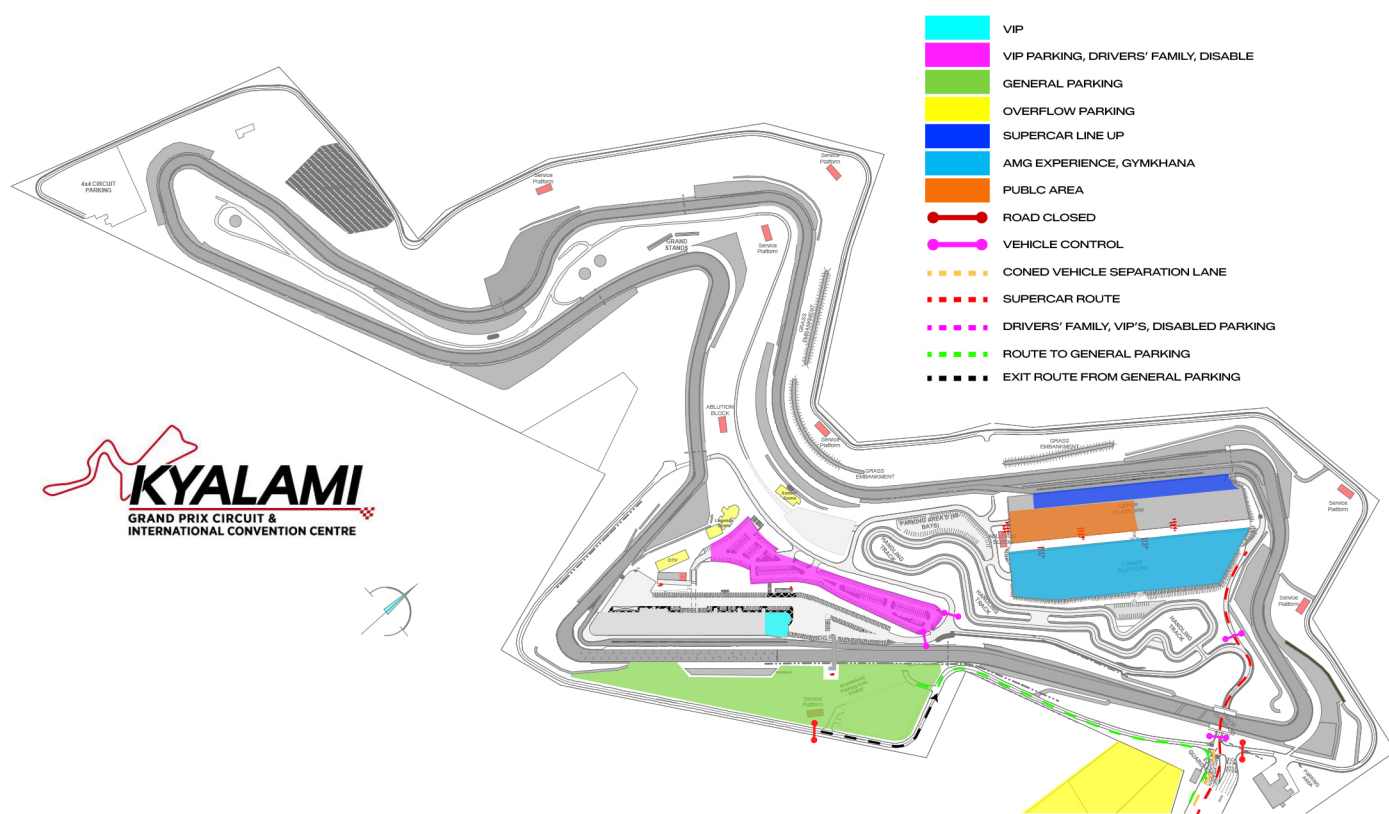

SAFETY GUIDELINES:

GYMKHANA + SPINNING ZONE

Vehicles are performing high-speed manoeuvres in this area. This is the most active vehicle zone on the circuit. Stay behind all barriers and cones at all times. Do not lean over, cross, or reach past any barrier. Photography from designated spots only.

WHEN THE CONVOY IS MOVING

250+ supercars will be moving on the circuit route. Never cross the Supercar Route when vehicles are in motion. Follow all marshal instructions immediately. Vehicle control marshals are stationed throughout. Always obey their direction without delay.

CHILDREN'S SAFETY

- Keep children within arm's reach at ALL times near any active vehicle area
- Ear protection is strongly recommended for young children near the circuit
- No running near any vehicle zones, routes or coned areas
- Grandstands are the safest viewing option for families with young children. If a child becomes separated, go immediately to the nearest marshal or contact Event Management on 082 686 5474
- Children must never approach or touch vehicles without direct permission from the owner and event staff
- Supervise children at ALL times near the Gymkhana and AMG Experience zone



OUR *story*

2021

The Supercar Rhino Run was founded, with 30 supercars helping feed 40 rhino orphans for one month.

2022

Participation doubled to 60 supercars, raising enough milk to feed every registered rhino orphan in South Africa for one month.

2023

The convoy grew to 80 supercars, with partnerships and prizes exceeding R90,000 and donations surpassing R100,000 in year two.

2024

The Supercar Rhino Run evolved into a powerful movement driven by passion, purpose, and growing community support.

2025

Building on 2024, the Supercar Rhino Run has grown into Africa's largest privately organised conservation initiative. With 180 supercars in attendance.

Since its inception, the Supercar Rhino Run has united 460 supercars, raised over R1.28M, donated 81 000 litres of milk, and supported 21 orphanages and sanctuaries - creating lasting impact for rhino conservation.
